One Nation Exchange provides free sewing training to women with barriers to employment, selling the products sewn to the direct benefit of the women who made them. Today, Lorelle is Executive Director of One Nation Exchange in addition to managing Arena Hand & Arm Clinic, which she opened with her husband in 2019.
